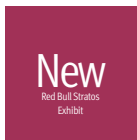
## Weston Family Innovation Centre

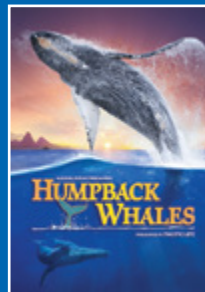
## Science Arcade
